



# **2024 VOLUNTEER GUIDE**

### October 14 - 20, 2024 The Country Club of Virginia, James River Course

Thank you for your interest in the 2024 Dominion Energy Charity Classic Volunteer Program presented by Drive Shack! The Dominion Energy Charity Classic is the first event of the Charles Schwab Cup Playoffs featuring the top 72 players on PGA TOUR Champions. Volunteers are essential to the success and execution of the Dominion Energy Charity Classic, so we invite you to join the team of 1,000+ dedicated volunteers who help make #DECCGolf happen each year.

## **REGISTRATION & COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS**

Volunteer Registration will open to the general public at 8 AM on Wednesday, May 15, 2024 at www.deccgolf.com. The tournament provides past volunteers, Dominion Energy employees and retirees, and CCV members the opportunity to register in advance of the public.

To understand the responsibilities and time commitment, please review the <u>2024 Committee Descriptions</u> prior to completing your registration. Your registration will be reviewed by the tournament staff upon completion, which can take up to two weeks.

### **COMMITTEE PLACEMENT**

All volunteers will be required to identify their top two committee choices on their application and will be placed on one of those committees, based on availability. **All volunteer committees are filled on a first-come, first-served basis, based on availability.** 

### YOUTH INVOLVEMENT

Junior Volunteers are welcome to volunteer at the Dominion Energy Charity Classic as a Standard Bearer (ages 13 – 18) or Pro-Am Caddie (ages 15 -18).



## **REQUIREMENTS & COMMITMENT**

All volunteers are required to work at least two shifts but are encouraged to work three. Shifts are approximately four (4) to six (6) hours in length. In signing up to volunteer, you are committing to your designated Committee Chairman and fellow volunteers. If you have any conflicts that arise after you have registered, please notify your Committee Chairman or the tournament staff immediately.

NEW FOR 2024: Volunteers who meet the minimum shift requirement will be entered into a raffle for tournament prizes (the raffle is separate from the volunteer golf outing). The more shifts you work, the more chances you have to win. Multiple winners will be selected after the event.

All volunteers<sup>\*</sup> are required to purchase the \$90 Dominion Energy Charity Classic volunteer package (retail value over \$400).

#### **VOLUNTEER TICKETS**

All active volunteers will receive two (2) digital tickets to each day of tournament play, Friday through Sunday, for family and/or friends. Volunteer credentials will provide access to the tournament on working and non-working days.

## **VOLUNTEER UNIFORM**

All volunteers are required to wear the 2024 Dominion Energy Charity Classic volunteer uniform while volunteering:

- Tournament-Issued Polo\*
- Outerwear & golf hat (optional)
- KHAKI colored pants, shorts or skort (no cargo pants, gym shorts or jeans)
- Comfortable shoes (no open-toed shoes)

#### Please DO NOT wear a uniform from a prior year.

In the event of weather, please layer but ensure one piece of your uniform and credential are visible. Personal rain gear and/or umbrellas are permitted as part of the volunteer uniform. On the days that volunteers are not working, please DO NOT wear the volunteer uniform.

\*Junior Standard Bearers must wear their tournament-issued t-shirt and Pro-Am Caddies must wear a tournamentissued caddie bib while volunteering.

## COMMUNICATION

Your Committee Chairman will be your main point of contact through tournament week. In the event of a schedule conflict, please contact your Committee Chairman immediately.

A monthly Volunteer Newsletter will be sent via email to all active volunteers with important tournament updates including information on Uniform Distribution, Volunteer Orientation, Tournament Week Schedule and more. Please be sure to periodically check your inboxes, junk and clutter folders for these important reminders.

## **VOLUNTEER ETIQUETTE**

All volunteers are an extension of the Dominion Energy Charity Classic team. Volunteers are asked to adhere to these guidelines:

- While in uniform, please do not ask for autographs or photos.
- Do not consume alcohol while working or in uniform.
- Please display the volunteer badge at all times.
- Please remain quiet and still during each shot until all players in the group have played out.
- Please kneel or sit down in the front row or inside the ropes.

## **VOLUNTEER SAFETY**

We encourage a culture of safety within the Dominion Energy Charity Classic Volunteer Program. We ask that volunteers review and pledge to adhere to these protocols while volunteering:

- 1. Follow all PGA TOUR Golf Cart, Utility Vehicle and Vehicle safety guidelines.
- 2. Wear comfortable, close-toed, and slip-resistant shoes.
- 3. Wear sunscreen, a hat and other protective clothing; check the weather daily to bring appropriate items.
- 4. Don't overexert, stay hydrated, ask for assistance when necessary, and take breaks when needed.
- 5. Practice proper lifting, pushing, and pulling techniques when moving objects.
- 6. Be sure to check in on your fellow volunteers and hold each other accountable to ensure safety.
- 7. Maintain a clean and orderly environment, free of trip hazards.
- 8. Be vigilant to surroundings to prevent being struck by a golf ball or equipment.
- 9. Use proper tools and personal protective equipment (PPE) to perform tasks.
- 10. Report unsafe conditions and incidents to Tournament Staff & Committee Chair immediately.

## **VOLUNTEER GOLF OUTING**

The Dominion Energy Charity Classic will host a Volunteer Golf Outing on November 11 at The Country Club of Virginia, James River Course in appreciation of our volunteers.

Due to space limitations, only 100 volunteers will be able to participate in the golf outing. All active volunteers are eligible and may opt in or out of the raffle during registration. Volunteers will be chosen at random and notified during tournament week. **Playing positions are non-transferable to other volunteers, family, friends or co-workers.** 

Volunteers must meet the minimum shift requirement to be eligible for the Volunteer Golf Outing.

#### **FOOD & BEVERAGE**

Continental breakfast will be served Monday through Sunday. Lunch will be served in Volunteer Village Monday through Wednesday. Upon check-in Thursday through Sunday, volunteers will be provided one meal voucher. This voucher is valid at any concession (not including Food Trucks). Concessions are open during gate hours. Beverages and snacks are available for volunteers all day, Monday through Sunday.

Food is only provided to volunteers on days worked.







## **PARKING & ACCESS**

Volunteers must have their volunteer credential to access tournament parking. The volunteer uniform alone does not grant access. There is NOT a separate shuttle for spectators and volunteers, so please prepare adequate time prior to your shift to park and shuttle to The Country Club of Virginia, James River Course. The shuttle ride is approximately 15 minutes.

#### **BIKE PARKING**

Bike Parking is located at the corner of St. Julians Lane and South Gaskins Road. There will be no tournament security at bike parking. If volunteers or spectators wish to lock up their bike, they must provide their own lock.

#### **CLUBHOUSE AND S. GASKINS ROAD ACCESS**

Tournament issued parking passes are required to access South Gaskins Road and the James River Clubhouse Wednesday through Sunday. Volunteers and spectators WILL NOT be permitted to be dropped off or picked up along South Gaskins Road or at the Clubhouse.

#### **RIDESHARE (5 minute shuttle ride)**

Ride Share drop-off and pick-up is located at Second Baptist Church on the corner of River and Gaskins Roads. Available Friday through Sunday during gate hours.
