CONFIRMATION & ASSIGNMENT

VOLUNTEER SCHEDULING

All volunteers are required to work at least two shifts.* The preferences you noted on your registration are **NOT** your schedule. Committee Chairs and Hole Captains will begin assigning and communicating volunteer schedules in the coming months. Please communicate directly with your Committee Chair or Hole Captain if there is a conflict.

To review your shift preferences, visit https://teamworks.r2it.com/web/ and create an account (first-time users) or sign in (returning users). When creating an account, you must utilize the same email used during registration. If you need to update your shift preferences after review, please email Kali Ryan Jones at kaliryanjones@pgatourhq.com.

Volunteers who meet the two-shift requirement will be eligible for the **Volunteer Golf Outing +** entered into a raffle for **DECC prizes! More shifts** = more chances to win. Multiple winners will be selected.

*Shifts are determined by the committee schedule. Pro-Am Caddies are only required to work one day to meet the minimum shift requirement. If a volunteer registered to be a Pro-Am caddie in addition to their primary assignment, they must work two shifts with their primary committee. The caddie assignment is supplemental.

VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES

VOLUNTEER ETIQUETTE

As an extension of the #DECCGOLF team, you must adhere to the following volunteer guidelines:

- The official DECC 2024 uniform is required, including the tournament-issued golf polo, khaki bottoms and closed-toed shoes. The tournament-issued hat and jacket are optional. Sandals, open-toed shoes, cargo pants, gym shorts or jeans are not permitted.
- Display your volunteer credential at all times.
- · Remain quiet and still during each shot until all players in the group have played out.
- While in uniform, do not drink alcohol or ask for autographs/photos.

VOLUNTEER SAFETY

- Follow all PGA TOUR Golf Cart, Utility Vehicle, Vehicle safety guidelines.
- Wear comfortable, close-toed, and slip-resistant shoes.
- Wear sunscreen, a hat and other protective clothing; check the weather daily to bring appropriate items.
- Don't overexert, stay hydrated, ask for assistance when necessary, and take breaks when needed.
- Practice proper lifting, pushing, and pulling techniques when moving objects.
- Be sure to check in on your fellow volunteers and hold each other accountable to ensure safety.
- Maintain a clean and orderly environment, free of trip hazards.
- Be vigilant to surroundings to prevent being struck by a golf ball or equipment.
- Use proper tools and personal protective equipment (PPE) to perform tasks.
- Report unsafe conditions and incidents to Tournament Staff & Committee Chair immediately.
